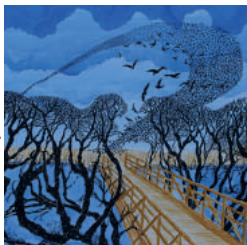

## YOUNG ARTISTS & COMMUNITY ART

Our festival is for everyone and so we encourage and celebrate art created locally by young people and in the community. Every year we involve around 500 Purbeck Young Artists (PYA) in schools across Purbeck in creative activities. Schools are encouraged to develop art works on the festival theme which this year is "Movement". The workshops have been coordinated by Helen Biles and we are most grateful for all the work she and her team of artists have put in over many months. The range of workshops span metalwork, cyanotype, rust printing, ceramics, mosaics, dance and 3D. You can see their results at Rollington Barn.

Thanks to The Friends of the Festival and all those acknowledged later in this brochure for supporting our work with young people.

We also create community art. Under the inspirational guidance of Dawn Newlove, Wareham primary school and the Purbeck Centre have been making a mural to adorn an otherwise blank wall in the refurbished garden of Wareham Library. Young people have painted tiles with scenes/characters from their favourite childhood stories... such a suitable theme for a library garden! Do go and admire their work and the creativity of everyone involved.

Carlotta Barrow has been leading the *Sea Life* project, inspired by the constant movement of the sea and the life beneath the waves. Stone panels have been prepared with a crest of a wave carved on the top to evoke the rolling waters, with pupils from The Swanage School, led by art teacher Sarah Mulhern developing their designs and carving the panels at the Burngate Stone Carving Centre. We are grateful to Lovell's Quarry for providing the pre-cut stone panels, to Scott Taylor for carving the waves, and to the Albion Quarry for providing 'practice' stone as well as various sponsors - notably the AONB (Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty). The completed panels will be placed alongside the garden path overlooking Swanage pier.

Jim O'Neill and Jon Snow look to be drifting our way as castaways for our Purbeck Island Discs.

**Jim O'Neill** (Baron O'Neill of Gatley) is the former chairman of Goldman Sachs Asset Management and best known for coining the acronym BRIC that stands for Brazil, Russia, India, and China – the four rapidly developing countries that came to symbolise the shift in global economic power away from the developed G-7 economies. He was appointed Commercial Secretary to the Treasury in the coalition government and resigned in September 2016. He sits on the board of the Northern Powerhouse and chaired a review that noted the dangers of over prescribing antibiotics. He has a home in Purbeck where he can often be seen out running when he is not at the Square & Compass!

**Jon Snow** is well known as the longest running presenter of Channel 4 News, which he has presented since 1989. His first job was to direct the new Horizon Centre day centre for homeless young people in central London and of which he subsequently became chairman. He was ITV's Washington correspondent and diplomatic editor before becoming the main presenter of Channel 4 News. He has reported on events around the world and has been a global champion of human rights, free speech and several charities ranging from the Prison Reform Trust, Ambitious about Autism, Trees for Cities (and the Heart of England Forest) and the Cyclists' Touring Club. He has described Purbeck as "the cherry on the icing on the cake".

Jack Daniels will play the recordings as our resident DJ.

Cornetts and sackbuts conjure up the definitive sound of 16th and 17th century Venice, when the floating city – rich, powerful, beautiful and home to some of the finest musicians Europe has ever produced – still reigned supreme in the Adriatic. This programme brings to life music that echoed around St Marks, entertained nobility in sumptuous palaces on the Grand Canal, or was performed in the winding streets and open squares of this most captivating of cities.

The English Cornett & Sackbut Ensemble is a virtuoso group of period instrument specialists who have performed at many major music festivals in the UK and abroad. They underpinned last year's performance of Orfeo by I Fagiolini. Their recital will offer works by Gabrieli, Monteverdi, de Rore, Grillo and many others, as well as introducing their new special portable chamber organ with impressively large bass organ pipes.

# Saving a piece of Swanage arts heritage



Swanage Bandstand, located on the recreation area above Shore Road, was manufactured by Walter MacFarlane and Co at the Saracen Foundry in Glasgow and installed in 1923. It is unusual in that as far as we can establish, it is the only existing bandstand built in an amphitheatre. Unemployed Swanage men, who had returned from WW1, were put to work digging out the amphitheatre as a public health exercise to improve their mental health.

Since its official opening in August 1923, Swanage Bandstand has hosted concerts, plays, musicals, beauty pageants, coronation, jubilee and naval celebrations. Swanage Town Band continues to play regular concerts at the Bandstand during the summer months.

Swanage Bandstand is one of only four remaining "MacFarlane 224" bandstands in the country, and so it is vital we save it.

With the support of Swanage Town Council, plans are now well underway to restore Swanage Bandstand. The Friends of Swanage Bandstand (FOSB) has become a registered charity (no. 1175077) and we are busy fundraising to secure the estimated £160,000 to restore the bandstand structure and seating area. As at January 2018 we have secured pledges and donations totalling £95,000. We are applying to the Heritage Lottery Fund and grant making trusts, and local individuals and groups are organising concerts, events and challenges to raise the rest.

FOSB's aim is to restore Swanage Bandstand to its former glory, re-using as much of the original structure as possible and with improved access and lighting. FOSB would love to hear from any local groups or individuals that would like to use it as a performance area or arts space once it is restored.

The local community and visitors alike have proved very generous, but we still have some way to go. After the resounding success of their performance last year of Monteverdi's opera *Orfeo*, I Fagiolini – under director Robert Hollingworth – have been tempted back to perform this recreation of a 1620 Vespers for the Feast of the Nativity of St John the Baptist at a Venetian church.

While the famous Mass/Vespers of 1610 includes the five Vespers psalms suitable to feasts of the Blessed Virgin and other female saints, it does not include a full set for any male saints. These were included in Monteverdi's 1641 publication, *Selva Morale e Spirituale* and this concert takes works from the latter compilation. As well as the main Vesper items including favourites such as *Beatus Vir*, it includes intriguing extras such as a sensuous Song of Songs motet, ornamentated music for the ravishing soundworld of *cornetto muto* plus four voices, violin solos and more.

Last year's performance by I Fagiolini finished with a tumultuous standing ovation by a full house. Don't miss this year's experience with soloists, organ, theorbos, violins and the English Cornett & Sackbut Ensemble.

This 1969 biography of modern-dance pioneer Isadora Duncan (Vanessa Redgrave), directed by Karel Reisz, details the performer's tumultuous life. The film reveals how the beautiful, outspoken and graceful American-born dancer rejected ballet and moved to Europe to pursue a freer form of movement. Duncan's many love affairs are also heavily featured, most notably her relationship with Paris Singer (Jason Robards), an heir to the Singer sewing-machine fortune, and the volatile Russian writer Sergei Yesenin (Ivan Tchenko). The film also stars James Fox as Gordon Craig.

It was nominated for an Academy Award and Golden Globe Award for Best Actress and BAFTA Awards for Best Sound and Best Costume Design. It was also nominated for the Palme d'Or at the Cannes Film Festival where Redgrave won Best Actress. The film was adapted by Melvyn Bragg, Margaret Drabble and Clive Exton from two books.

The Fieri Consort present a carefully picked selection of Italian madrigals 'Englished' by an unknown gentleman, published in the 1588 anthology *Musica Transalpina*, featuring works by Ferrabosco, Conversi, Marenzio, Lasso and Palestrina, as well as England's own William Byrd. The intimate relationship between words and music was maintained as far as possible to demonstrate the key to the Italian madrigal form, and English composers took inspiration from the Italian style but made it their own. Hence the English madrigal was born, flourished and developed into its own genre extremely quickly.

Full programme notes and translations of the words are set out in the Events Programme, £2 from Tourist Offices, selected shops and at our events.

The Fieri Consort evolved out of The Sixteen's Young Artists Programme: Genesis Sixteen and last year were winners of the Cambridge Prize at the prestigious York Early Music Festival. Now in its sixth year, it is recognized as one of the country's most exciting vocal groups, described as producing '*intricately-blended and immaculately-controlled vocal lines*'.
