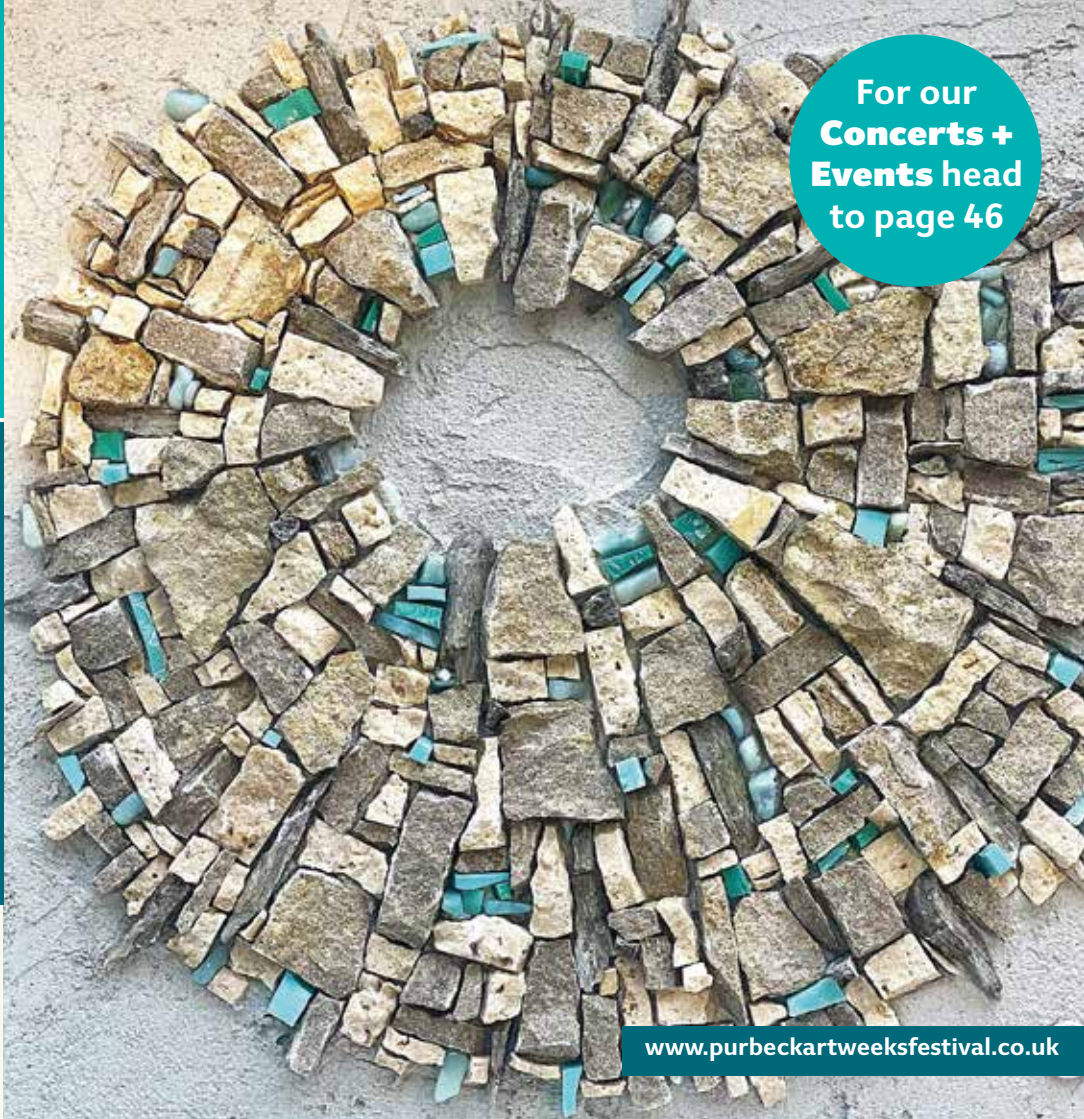

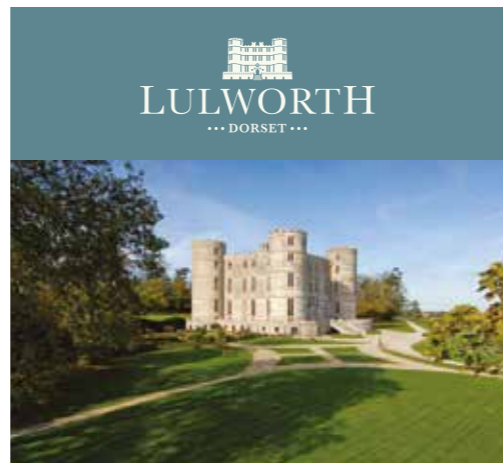

# Welcome to Purbeck Art Weeks 2026!

It's Festival time again! Across Purbeck open studios, concerts, workshops and a talk are on offer showcasing exceptional local and international talent. All the details are here in our Festival Brochure or on our website.

**Open Studio** artists, new and more established, are ready to welcome you with their paintings, sculptures, glass work, textiles, prints, ceramics and more. **Rollington Barn** (near Corfe Castle) is the festival hub.

Here you can explore our huge eclectic **Collective Exhibition** and the **Pop-Up Studio tent** where different artists are in action every day. The **Courtyard Café** serves delicious food, cakes and coffee – and is the ideal place to plan your itinerary and work out which open studios you'd like to visit, and which concerts and events you'd like to book. Across the way, in **The Byre**, is an imaginative display of work based on the theme of 'birds' by young people involved in our **Purbeck Young Artists** scheme, with links to the **Whispering Dome** event.

Do visit our new **INFORMATION POINT** at Rollington Barn where you can find out about all our concerts, talks, workshops and other activities.

In Corfe you will find a specially **curated exhibition of Purbeck artists in the Castle View Welcome Centre**, developed in partnership with the National Trust. This is during the second week of PAW only.

Music abounds – with an exciting mix of **concerts** both instrumental and vocal. We're thrilled that **I Fagiolini** are back to open the Festival singing the best of the best from Elizabethan madrigals to brand new modern compositions (May 29). Our famous mini music fest is over the

middle weekend – do check out the details. On the last weekend don't miss **The Whispering Dome**, Mowlem Theatre (June 5) – an award-winning, cross-cultural, performance based on the migration of nightingales and involving local schools and choirs. The Festival closes with **Guy Cutting**, tenor, singing Handel arias with period instruments (June 6). There's something for everyone!

We are delighted that Dr Gill Clarke is coming to give us an illustrated **talk on Creative Relationships: Artists in Purbeck 1900-1950** (May 26) – she is an expert on twentieth century art and passionate about Purbeck's artistic heritage.

The **Purbeck Poets** are once again offering their friendly open mic poetry evening. Free to all.

We have workshops you can get involved in too – a **singing workshop** for all levels with Grace Newcombe (May 30), and a **Flying Beasties workshop for children (4-8yrs)** with Nick Jubber in Wareham (May 28).

We hope you all find something that excites and inspires you during our celebration of the arts and community in Purbeck!

This is my last festival as PAW Chair but not my last as a Trustee, and I would like to say what a great pleasure and privilege it has been to be part of such an enthusiastic team of music and art lovers and practitioners. With Ian Godfrey ready at the helm, we are looking forward to marking our 25th Anniversary next year!

Across the Isle of Purbeck our artists' studios are open for you to enjoy. You will find a huge range of art to explore – painters, printmakers, photographers, sculptors, metal workers, jewellers, glass workers, ceramicists, wood workers, textile artists and much more. Our artists are looking forward to welcoming you!

Entry to all studios and exhibitions is free, and provides a fantastic opportunity to see where, and how, our artists are inspired and work.

Look out for the small yellow and blue PAW direction signs – or have a look at the PAW Map on the back of your brochure and plan your trail around your tastes, timescale, or transport. More information will be available at Rollington Barn. There is a good local bus service and the Swanage Railway steam train, and bicycles can be hired at Wareham Station.

You may like to take your credit card with you (or cheque book) just in case temptation strikes. Many Open Studios have card machines, but not all. Or you can secure your latest art related purchase by paying a deposit.

Please respect individual Open Studios' guidance to visitors. # OUR CONCERTS AND EVENTS

PAW Festival 2026 brings together music, visual art, and poetry in a vibrant programme of nine concerts, alongside an illustrated talk, a children's storytelling workshop, a vocal workshop and our annual open mic poetry evening.

Festival favourites **I Fagiolini** open with a characteristically bold programme *We're Not Dead Yet*, celebrating 40 years of their existence. Rising stars **Parnassus Ensemble** perform cantatas by Bach, Kuhnau, and Pachelbel, with artist **Jérémie Queyras** painting live in response. Russell-Cotes curator **Dr Gill Clarke** presents an illustrated talk on 20th-century artists living in or visiting Purbeck who crossed artistic boundaries, and award-winning local author **Nick Jubber** inspires children with the myths and mysteries of flying creatures.

Central to our festival events is a specially curated festival weekend running from 29–31 May with five concerts. We begin at Sandy Hill Arts with leading medieval specialist **Grace Newcombe** and her trio, reimagining songs from the South West through medieval-

folk fusion. Grace also leads a vocal workshop exploring the sound world of Middle England, and performs an intimate duo programme of medieval songs with **Elizabeth Sommers**. Violinist **Lizzie Ball** and accordionist **Miloš Milivojević** bring to life the creative and passionate relationship between Coco Chanel and Igor Stravinsky, while **Fieri Consort** explores the remarkable female voices of 16th-century Italy. In a late-night concert, lutenist **Toby Carr** launches his solo album *Softest Thunder*.

For the final weekend, *The Whispering Dome* unites professional musicians with local singers and children in traditional music from Morocco, The Gambia, and Europe, tracing the nightingale's migratory path. The festival closes with tenor **Guy Cutting** and a stellar period-instrument ensemble in a glorious programme of Handel opera and oratorio.

Curator and art historian **Gill Clarke** will talk about leading artists who were resident or visiting Purbeck between 1900-1950, giving us a fascinating insight into the area’s rich artistic heritage. Painting holidays were popular with Slade School of Art tutors including Philip Wilson Steer and Henry Tonks. Paul Nash painted some of his best-known work in Swanage where he met Eileen Agar. Vanessa Bell and Roger Fry holidayed in Studland. Francis Newbery, Head of Glasgow School of Art, retired to Corfe where Frances Hodgkins later made her home. All were inspired by Purbeck’s distinctive scenery including the Spencer Watson family in nearby Dunshay. Their creative relationships led to work that crossed artistic boundaries.

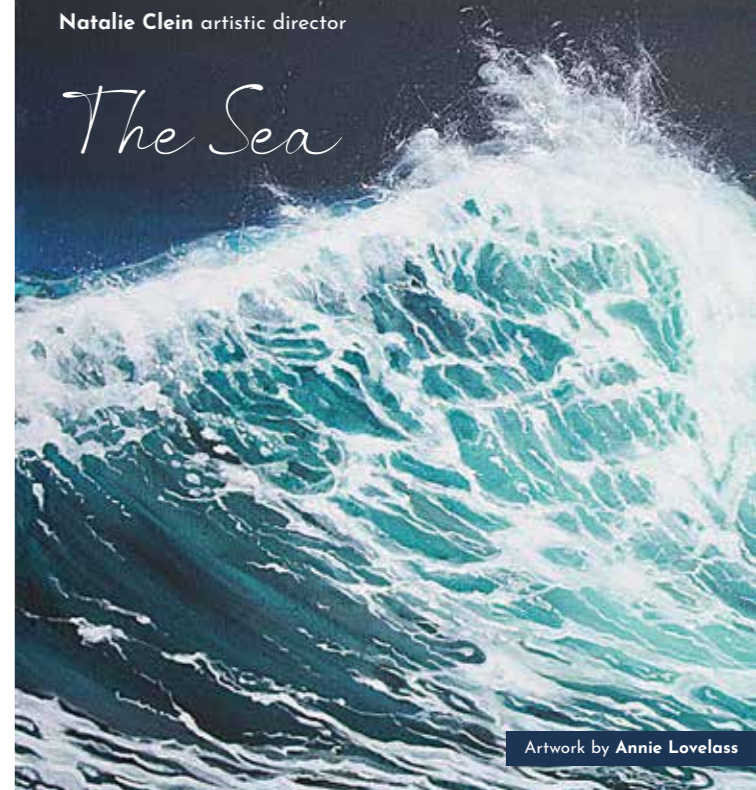

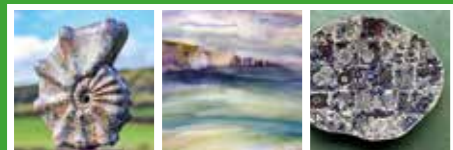
